Entry Fees: £16 per class

Entries close the Tuesday before each show. Late entries may be accepted if there is availability in the class. Any late entry will incur an additional £1 charge.

All entries to be made online via Horse Monkey. No email/telephone entries will be accepted.

If you require a caller for your tests, then pre-booking is required and a £2 donation to Cancer Research UK to be paid on the day, and before you ride your test/s. We cannot guarantee that we will have availability for any test calling that is booked on the day of the competition.

Where any class is split into two different tests, the competitor may enter one or both tests in that class. When entering this class, please state in your entry notes which test you would like to ride.

All Intro and Prelim classes will have an **Under 14** years section. Intro riders may be led, and we strongly recommend that handlers wear a riding hat and gloves. Please state on your entry notes if the rider wishes to be entered into the **Under 14** section or if the competitor is being led in the classes.

General Information

Your entry shall imply your knowledge and acceptance of the Event T&C's

Entrants accept that any photographs taken by the official event photographer may be used by Speedgate Enterprises Ltd for marketing purposes.

No transfer or refund of entries will be given once entries have closed.

Our unaffiliated dressage competitions will run in accordance with British Dressage rules. Competitor dress, tack and equipment must all be in line with current BD rulings. Any illegal tack or equipment used will result in the rider being able to ride the test but will be scored as riding Hors Concours.

All horses **must** wear two bridle numbers visible on both sides of the horse. These can be worn either on the bridle or saddlecloth. If a number is not worn or an incorrect number is shown, then two penalties will be deducted from your score.

Restrictions

Intro classes are open to Horse and Rider combinations never to have been placed at Prelim level or above.

Preliminary classes are open to Horse and Rider combinations never to have won at Novice level or above.

Novice classes are open to Horse and Rider combinations never to have won at Elementary level or above.

These events are aimed to encourage amateur riders into the sport. Anyone deemed to be riding in a class below their ability please have the courtesy to ride H/C. This will need to be declared in the notes section of your entry or before the commencement of the class.
