Entry fees: £15 per person. Minimum of three members and maximum four members per team.

All entries to be made on-line via **Horse Monkey.** No email/telephone entries will be accepted.

Entries close the Tuesday before each show. Times will be available on the Thursday before each show, and they will be emailed out to all competitors, via Horse Monkey.

Please note that we do not offer a test calling service at this event. Please try to organise between your team members to call for each other.

Team Composition

Teams can compete with a minimum of three and a maximum of four different combinations. Horses may be ridden twice on the same team, at the same or different levels, if ridden by two different riders. If a combination competes for two teams on the same day, they must ride at two different levels. Teams can be made up of riders all competing at the same level, or a combination of different levels. Restrictions of riders will apply.

Please notify us of your chosen 'Team Name' and team members when making your entry.

Jackets are not compulsory, and riders are encouraged to wear smart casual 'colours' of their choice. This can be an appropriate shirt/ t-shirt with short or long sleeves. Sleeveless shirts will <u>not</u> be permitted. Safety is paramount, so appropriate riding footwear and protective headwear in accordance too BD rules must be worn.

All horses must wear their competition numbers visible on both sides of the horse. These can be worn either the bridle or saddle cloth. If only one number is worn or an incorrect number is shown, then two penalties will be deducted.

Restrictions

Walk and Trot classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have been placed at Prelim level or above. Preliminary classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have won at Novice level or above. Novice classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have won at Elementary level or above. Elementary classes are open to all.

Scoring

Team placings are determined by adding together the three highest counting percentages to produce a team total. The team with the highest team score will be the winners

If teams achieve the same total percentage, the winning team will be determined by the team whose lowest scoring team member, has the highest percentage.

Combinations who have been eliminated, withdrawn or retired will not be counted towards the team total.
